The Committee discussed how to handle the projects with a risk for non-completion by April 2011. FMO presented a memo for discussion suggesting a split in categories for the various possible project situations when the last date of eligibility cannot be reached. The overall objective of the policy is to ensure a proper completion of all projects funded by the FMs 2004-09.

The Committee adopted the memo.

4 Guidelines and policy issues

4.1 Public register

For the 2009-14 FM, the FMO presented its recommendation to establish an online Public register as part of the new Information and Reporting System. The Committee discussed the recommendation. The Committee adopted the Public Register document with the following amendment: Donor Partnership Agreements should



be listed with documents with limited access.

The Committee asked for documents to be equally accessible under either Financial Mechanism, preferably through a web site. Coherence with EFTA rules was underlined. The Committee then agreed that the Public Access Policy applies for both Financial Mechanisms (2004-09 and 2009-14).

5 Administrative issues

5.1 Semi-Annual Activity plan spring 2011

The FMO presented the semi-annual activity plan for spring 2011. The Committee took note of the plan.
